R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Prosper High School baseball team reached the  
2 pinnacle of success by winning the 2015 University Interscholastic  
3 League 5A state championship on June 12 at the Dell Diamond in Round  
4 Rock; and

5           WHEREAS, After going undefeated in district play, the Eagles  
6 began the postseason with an impressive series win over Frisco  
7 Centennial High School, in which they came back from a loss in the  
8 opener to take the second game 18-6 and the third 15-3; they  
9 continued their streak with a string of victories against  
10 Carrollton Smith, Frisco, Sulphur Springs, and Frisco Wakeland High  
11 Schools to punch their ticket to the state tournament; and

12           WHEREAS, In the semifinals, Prosper overcame an early deficit  
13 to defeat Tomball High School 6-2, before going up against the squad  
14 from Georgetown High School with the title on the line; in that  
15 contest, both teams got off to a slow start in the first inning, but  
16 the Eagles rallied to rattle off six runs in the second inning,  
17 followed by another two in the third, and winning pitcher and  
18 championship game Most Valuable Player Kylor Morris turned in a  
19 dominant performance that kept the opponents off the scoreboard;  
20 the Eagles emerged triumphant with an 8-0 victory to claim the crown  
21 and close out a memorable season with a total of 35 wins and only 3  
22 losses; and

23           WHEREAS, Excelling with a true team effort, the Eagles  
24 received significant contributions throughout the season from each

1 member of the roster, and these talented student-athletes were  
2 inspired to play at the top of their game by head coach Rick  
3 Carpenter and assistant coaches Shaun Stanton, Clay Wilson, Zach  
4 Wilson, and Mark Cain; and

5 WHEREAS, The Prosper High School baseball team demonstrated  
6 exemplary teamwork and an unwavering commitment to excellence, and  
7 the players and their many supporters in the local community will  
8 forever cherish the memory of this outstanding accomplishment; now,
