## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas Commission on the Arts has announced the 2 2018 appointments for the positions of State Poet Laureate, State State Two-Dimensional 3 Musician, Artist, and State Three-Dimensional Artist; and 4 5 WHEREAS, The state's highest accolade for excellence in the arts, designation as a Texas State Artist is conferred on those 6 7 individuals who represent the best of our rich and diverse artistic community and who inspire others through their unique creative 8 9 expression; the nominations process for the awards is overseen by

10 the TCA, and the final selections are made by a committee whose

11 members are appointed by the governor, the lieutenant governor, and

12 the speaker of the house of representatives; and

13 WHEREAS, Carol Coffee Reposa has been named the 2018 State 14 Poet Laureate; she is the author of four books of poetry, and her poems, reviews, and essays have appeared in such publications as 15 16 the Atlanta Review, the Evansville Review, the Texas Observer, Southwestern American Literature, and the Valparaiso Poetry 17 Review; repeatedly recognized for her work, she has been a finalist 18 for the Malahat Review Long Poem Prize and a winner of the Guadalupe 19 20 Cultural Arts Center poetry contest; she has also garnered an Arts 21 and Letters Award from the Friends of the San Antonio Public Library, received several Pushcart Prize nominations, and been 22 23 inducted into the Texas Institute of Letters; a professor emerita of English at San Antonio College, she serves today as poetry editor 24

1 of Voices de la Luna; and

WHEREAS, The 2018 State Musician is pianist, songwriter, and 2 3 vocalist Marcia Ball, whose soulful ballads and rhythmic blues numbers, inspired by her upbringing in Texas and Louisiana, have 4 5 earned her international acclaim; she is an inductee of the Museum of the Gulf Coast Music Hall of Fame and the Louisiana Music Hall of 6 Fame, as well as the recipient of 10 Blues Music Awards, 8 Living 7 8 Blues Awards, and 5 Grammy Award nominations; over the years, she has traveled around the globe, performing for fans at countless 9 10 festivals, concert halls, and clubs; and 11 WHEREAS, Fort Worth native Sedrick Huckaby has been selected 12 as the State Two-Dimensional Artist; an assistant professor at The University of Texas at Arlington, where he has taught since 2009, he 13 14 holds a bachelor's degree from Boston University and a master's 15 degree from Yale University; Mr. Huckaby draws his inspiration from African American domestic life, and his impressive works have been 16 17 displayed at the Art Institute of Chicago, the Minneapolis Institute of Art, and the Whitney Museum of American Art; since 18 19 embarking on his career in 1999, he has received many distinctions, including a Guggenheim Fellowship, a Provincetown Fellowship, and a 20 Joan Mitchell Foundation grant; among his most recent awards has 21 been a 2016 prize in the Outwin Boochever Portrait Competition, 22 23 hosted by the National Portrait Gallery of the Smithsonian 24 Institution; and WHEREAS, Named the 2018 State Three-Dimensional Artist, 25 26 Beili Liu uses common materials and elements to create

installations that explore complex cultural issues; her work has

- 7 Mayor's Award for her contributions to cultural exchange; a native
- 8 of Jilin, China, she holds a master's degree from the University of
- 9 Michigan and is currently a professor of art at The University of
- 10 Texas at Austin; and

- 12 prestigious posts have all greatly contributed to the vibrant
- 13 cultural life of the Lone Star State, and Texas is indeed fortunate
- 14 to be home to these talented individuals; now, therefore, be it
