

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The boys' track and field team from Cypress
2 Christian School in Houston proved itself one of the finest squads
3 in the state by placing second overall at the Texas Association of
4 Private and Parochial Schools 4A Track & Field State Meet held at
5 Hart Stadium in Waco May 5-6, 2017; and

6 WHEREAS, The Warriors were paced in individual events by John
7 Ethan Baldwin, who placed first in the 300-meter hurdles with a time
8 of 39.8 seconds and third in both the long and triple jumps with
9 leaps of 21 feet, 8.5 inches and 42 feet, 8.25 inches, respectively;
10 moreover, Cole Miller captured the silver medal in the 400-meter
11 dash with a time of 50.39 seconds, and Foster Paulsen finished
12 second in the discus throw with a distance of 127 feet, 9 inches;
13 fine performances were also turned in by Jacob Hotchkiss in the
14 800-meter dash, Tyler Landua in the 110-meter hurdles and the
15 triple jump, and Austin Henry in the 300-meter hurdles; and

16 WHEREAS, In team events, Mr. Baldwin and Mr. Miller joined
17 forces with Ian Jones and Jackson Landrum to clinch the silver medal
18 in the 4x100-meter relay with a time of 43.59 seconds; in addition,
19 the quartet of Mr. Baldwin, Mr. Miller, Mr. Landrum, and
20 Mr. Hotchkiss turned in a fourth-place finish in the 4x400-meter
21 relay; and

22 WHEREAS, Aply guided by head coach Timothy Honeycutt, these
23 talented student-athletes have excelled through skill, hard work,
24 and an unwavering commitment to perform at the highest level, and

1 they are a source of tremendous pride to their classmates and to
2 their many supporters in the local community; now, therefore, be it

4 Legislature hereby congratulate the Cypress Christian School boys'
5 track and field team on placing second overall at the 2017 TAPPS 4A
