1           WHEREAS, A banner year for Bremond High School quarterback  
2 Roshauud Paul culminated in his receipt of the 2016 Mr. Texas  
3 Football High School Player of the Year Award, which was presented  
4 by *Dave Campbell's Texas Football* magazine and Wells Fargo at the  
5 AdvoCare V100 Texas Bowl on December 28; and

6           WHEREAS, During the 2016 football season, Mr. Paul burnished  
7 his already stellar record with 2,892 yards rushing, 2,256 yards  
8 passing, and 82 touchdowns; moreover, he was also a standout player  
9 on defense, racking up over 50 tackles and 4 interceptions; he  
10 piloted the Tigers to the University Interscholastic League Class  
11 2A Division 2 final, where they extended their winning streak to 47  
12 games and captured their third consecutive state championship while  
13 Mr. Paul notched his third Offensive Most Valuable Player Award;  
14 his other accolades include the 2016 Class 2A Offensive Player of  
15 the Year award from the Texas Associated Press Sports Editors and  
16 All-American Second Team honors from MaxPreps; and

17           WHEREAS, Mr. Paul graduated from Bremond High in December  
18 2016; he has accepted an athletic scholarship from Texas A&M  
19 University and will begin playing for the Aggies in 2017; and

20           WHEREAS, Over the course of his high school career, Roshauud  
21 Paul distinguished himself as one of the finest football players in  
22 the Lone Star State and in the nation as a whole, and he is indeed  
23 deserving of this coveted honor; now, therefore, be it
