1 WHEREAS, Mallory Smith of Henrietta M. King High School in  
2 Kingsville has been named a 2017 Miss Buc Days Scholar through the  
3 Buc Days Youth Leadership Program; and

4 WHEREAS, Affiliated with Rodeo Corpus Christi and the Buc  
5 Days Festival, the program accepts 20 seniors each year; the 10 Miss  
6 Buc Days Scholars and 10 Buc Days King Scholars are chosen on the
