- 1 WHEREAS, The Sachse Historical Society is sponsoring the
- 2 exhibition of the Moving Wall Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Sachse
- 3 from May 26 through 29, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, Designed by Maya Lin, the original Vietnam Veterans
- 5 Memorial in Washington, D.C., is a striking V-shaped wall of black
- 6 granite etched with the names of the nearly 58,000 men and women who
- 7 gave their lives during the Vietnam War; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In 1982, Vietnam veteran John Devitt attended the
- 9 dedication of the memorial and was deeply moved; working with
- 10 Norris Shears, Gerry Haver, and other veterans, he created a
- 11 half-scale traveling replica in order to share this profound
- 12 experience with those who do not have the opportunity to visit the
- 13 original; the Moving Wall was first displayed in Tyler in 1984, and
- 14 today, two versions of the wall travel the nation from April through
- 15 November each year; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The wall's visit to Sachse is being sponsored by the
- 17 Sachse Historical Society, whose volunteers have worked tirelessly
- 18 to make the necessary preparations; after arriving under motorcycle
- 19 escort, the wall will be installed on the grounds of Sachse City
- 20 Hall; the weekend will culminate in a solemn Memorial Day ceremony
- 21 that will feature remarks by veteran and keynote speaker Ed Taylor;

- 23 WHEREAS, Through the selfless efforts of the historical
- 24 society's volunteers, the residents of Sachse and the surrounding
