6 baseball, softball, and football coach; after taking on the role of
7 head coach of the Indians baseball team during the 2002-2003
8 season, he was named interim head coach of the Lady Indians in 2007
9 and then returned to the position of head coach for the following
10 year; and

12 has compiled an impressive list of accomplishments; he has helped
13 guide the Indians baseball team to 28 postseason berths, including
14 three appearances in the University Interscholastic League state
15 tournament and two in the state finals; moreover, he played an
16 instrumental role in piloting the 1992 football team to the UIL 4A
17 championship title; and

19 role model to countless young Texans, and he may indeed reflect with
20 pride on his numerous achievements as he embarks on the next
