

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Del Mar College established its Center for
2 Mexican-American Studies during the 2016-2017 school year; and

3 WHEREAS, The center was founded to further the mission of the
4 college's Mexican-American Studies program, sponsor events related
5 to the MAS curriculum, and expand cultural awareness and
6 appreciation in the wider community; the center provides resources
7 and learning experiences for students and the public, and it will
8 also promote the Mike Anzaldúa MAS Memorial Scholarship and other
9 scholarship opportunities; and

10 WHEREAS, The Mexican-American Studies program is aligned
11 with the college's designation as a Hispanic-serving institution;
12 efforts to develop a degree plan in the discipline gained traction
13 in 2003 with support from the 78th Texas Legislature for
14 introducing such course work in public community colleges; and

15 WHEREAS, In 2008, Del Mar reintroduced a course in
16 Mexican-American literature and has since added to the curriculum
17 an Introduction to Mexican-American Studies, as well as classes in
18 Mexican-American politics, history, and fine arts; in 2011, the
19 college implemented the associate degree in Mexican-American
20 Studies; and

21 WHEREAS, The establishment of the Center for
22 Mexican-American Studies marks the beginning of a new era for the
23 MAS program at Del Mar College, and the center is sure to enhance
24 opportunities for educational and cultural enrichment for students

1 and local residents alike; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
3 Legislature hereby commemorate the establishment of the Del Mar
4 College Center for Mexican-American Studies and extend to all those
5 associated with the center sincere best wishes for the future; and,
6 be it further

7 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
8 prepared for the center as an expression of high regard by the Texas
9 House of Representatives.
