WHEREAS, The son of Jimmy and Shirley Wasson, Charley Wasson was born in Fritch on December 8, 1975; as a young man, he often worked with his grandparents on the family farm, and his character was further shaped by his participation in debate and the Boy Scouts, where he attained the rank of Eagle Scout; and

9 WHEREAS, After receiving a bachelor's degree in English and a 10 master's degree in sports management and marketing from Texas Tech 11 University, Mr. Wasson embarked on a career in cancer and hospice 12 care; beginning in 1999, he worked for Covenant Health, first at the Joe Arrington Cancer Research and Treatment Center and later as the 13 14 executive director and CEO of Hospice of Lubbock and the Covenant palliative care program; in recognition of his outstanding efforts, 15 he received the 2015 Values in Action Award for Justice from 16 Covenant Health; and 17

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Wasson contributed to his professional 19 community as a member of the Texas and New Mexico Hospice 20 Organization and the Texas Non-Profit Hospice Alliance boards; he 21 also held leadership roles with a number of worthy civic groups, 22 including Women's Protective Services; and

WHEREAS, Beloved by many for his warmth, compassion, and good
humor, Mr. Wasson was especially devoted to his nieces and nephews;

1 he remained loyal all his life to the Texas Tech Red Raiders, and 2 his other interests included photography, travel, and movies; he 3 was also a man of strong religious faith and a valued congregant of 4 First United Methodist Church; and
