WHEREAS, Born in Dallas on December 30, 1959, Jamie Barkham 4 5 was the son of Jim and Ninva Barkham and the brother of Cindy, Laurie, and Jeanine; he graduated from Skyline High School in 1978 6 7 and subsequently earned an associate degree in applied arts and science; he went on to work at Steakley Chevrolet for two decades 8 9 before accepting a position with Southwest Airlines, where he served as a ground support equipment and plant maintenance mechanic 10 11 for 18 years; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Barkham joined the Forney Fire Department as a volunteer firefighter in January 1987, and over the years, he 13 14 steadily advanced through the ranks, serving in a number of leadership roles before earning promotion to assistant chief; in 15 16 honor of his exemplary efforts, he was named Firefighter of the Year multiple times; he was also presented with a Life Saving Award and a 17 CareFlite letter of recognition, and in 2013, he received a 18 certificate of excellence from Texas State Senator Bob Deuell for 19 standing vigil for the firefighters killed by the fertilizer plant 20 21 explosion in West; and

22 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Barkham shared 32 23 rewarding years of marriage with his wife, Laurie, and their 24 treasured family eventually grew to include their two sons, Brent
