## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Every year on Patriot Day, Americans reflect on the
- 2 tragic events of September 11, 2001, honoring the thousands of
- 3 innocent people who were killed and the many thousands more who
- 4 joined together in the wake of catastrophe to protect, comfort, and
- 5 serve the residents of this great nation; and
- 6 WHEREAS, On that infamous September morning, 19 terrorists
- 7 hijacked four civilian aircraft and perpetrated one of the most
- 8 horrific crimes in American history; two of the planes were used to
- 9 bring down the twin towers of the World Trade Center in New York
- 10 City while another targeted the Pentagon; the fourth airplane,
- 11 United Flight 93, crashed in the Pennsylvania countryside thanks to
- 12 the heroic resistance of its passengers; and
- WHEREAS, All told, nearly 3,000 people died as a result of
- 14 those attacks, including more than 400 New York first responders,
- 15 184 individuals at the Pentagon, and the 40 passengers of Flight 93;
- 16 and
- WHEREAS, In the months following the attacks, the Congress of
- 18 the United States passed a joint resolution designating September
- 19 11 as Patriot Day; on that day, Americans pause for a moment of
- 20 silence, during which we remember those we have lost, pay tribute to
- 21 those who have fought and sacrificed to defend our way of life, and
- 22 renew our commitment to our neighbors, our ideals, and our country;
