- 16 father of Kym Michalik, Ken Butts, Debbie Braganza, and Carrie
- 17 Ashley, and in later years, he became the grandfather of Jordan,

- 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Butts battled Parkinson's disease for two
- 20 decades but did not let his illness define him; an avid
- 21 photographer, he viewed the world through his camera lens; he

- 24 collections; when he wanted a change of scenery, he loved to go

- 3 University of Southern California; a longtime fan of the Fighting

- 7 behind, they will forever treasure their memories of time spent in
