2 School achieved great distinction by winning the University
3 Interscholastic League 6A girls' doubles tennis state championship
4 on May 19, 2017, at the state tournament in College Station; and

6 the title match by triumphing in their quarterfinal and semifinal
7 matches in straight sets against opponents from Houston Memorial
8 and Austin Westlake High Schools, respectively; the Midland High

10 School in a hard-fought three-set contest, 6-2, 4-6, and 6-3, to
11 claim the 6A crown; and

13 first state girls' doubles crown for Midland High School in 45 years
14 and capped an undefeated season in which they compiled a sterling
15 45-0 record; along the way, they benefited from the skillful
16 guidance of head coach Carmen Stewart; and

18 countless hours of hard work and an enduring commitment to
19 excellence, and these talented student-athletes will treasure the
20 memory of this accomplishment for the rest of their lives; now,
