RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, More than three million Americans are estimated to
- 2 suffer from glaucoma, the leading cause of preventable blindness in
- 3 the United States; and
- WHEREAS, Glaucoma is a group of eye diseases characterized by
- 5 gradual damage to the optic nerve, which over time causes
- 6 irreversible vision loss; in the early stages of its most common
- 7 form, there are virtually no symptoms, and many sufferers are
- 8 unaware that they have the disease until significant and permanent
- 9 damage is done; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Although a cure has yet to be found, early detection
- 11 is crucial to slowing optic nerve damage and preserving eyesight in
- 12 patients with glaucoma; the need for greater awareness is
- 13 particularly acute in certain high-risk groups, including the
- 14 elderly, diabetics, and persons of African, Asian, and Hispanic
- 15 descent, who are encouraged to be proactive in protecting their eye
- 16 health by undergoing regular examinations; and
- WHEREAS, Glaucoma can be treated and managed if detected in
- 18 time, and National Glaucoma Awareness Month in January provides an
- 19 important opportunity to promote education about this debilitating
- 20 disease; now, therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 22 Legislature hereby recognize National Glaucoma Awareness Month in
- 23 January 2018 and urge Texans to learn more about glaucoma detection
- 24 and treatment.
