RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The heritage of the vaquero remains vital in South
- 2 Texas, and the central role this colorful and iconic figure has
- 3 played in the history of the Lone Star State is being celebrated
- 4 with Vaquero Day on June 30, 2017; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Renowned for their horsemanship and stock-handling
- 6 skills, vaqueros were crucial to the advance of Spanish ranching
- 7 into Texas; from the mid-18th century onward, vaqueros figured
- 8 significantly in the development of large, open-range cattle
- 9 ranches in the region between the Nueces River and the Rio Grande,
- 10 traces of which can still be seen on the land in the form of
- 11 fortified stone blockhouses, ranch outbuildings, chapels and
- 12 cemeteries, hand-dug wells, and the man-made reservoirs that made
- 13 it possible to assemble enormous herds; and
- 14 WHEREAS, With the expansion of the Texas cattle industry in
- 15 the 19th century, the vaquero's traditions shaped ranching
- 16 practices all across the state, and much of the vaquero's
- 17 equipment--his chaps, bandana, sombrero, lasso, spurs, and
- 18 saddle--became standard gear for all Texas cowboys, while other
- 19 elements of his craft, such as mounted herding and roping
- 20 techniques, also influenced early Anglo American practices;
- 21 eventually, these vaquero-inspired methods of working cattle
- 22 spread across the High Plains and the western part of the United
- 23 States; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Today, the proud culture of the vaquero is being

- 1 kept alive by such notable organizations as the Vaqueros of South
- 2 Texas, whose members work to preserve the vaquero tradition for
- 3 future generations; and
- WHEREAS, Through a deep appreciation of the land and through
- 5 skills honed over the course of centuries, the vaquero has
- 6 contributed immeasurably to the history, culture, and economy of
- 7 South Texas and to the rich ranching heritage of the Lone Star State
- 8 and the American West; now, therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 10 Legislature hereby recognize June 30, 2017, as Vaquero Day and
- 11 commend the members of Vaqueros of South Texas for their fidelity to
- 12 the generations of vaqueros who came before them.
