1 WHEREAS, The city of Amarillo lost an admired civic leader 2 with the death of Keith Roger Williams on May 19, 2017, at the age of 3 65; and

WHEREAS, The son of L. Keith and Bonnie Williams, Roger
Williams was born on September 10, 1951, and grew up in Kansas City,
Missouri; he completed both his bachelor's and master's degrees at
Brigham Young University; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Williams was the proud father of three children 9 by his first marriage, Stewart, Marissa, and Marshall, and 10 following his marriage to Ana Estevez on December 26, 2003, he 11 welcomed two more children, Nikki and Alexis, into his treasured 12 family; moreover, he took great delight in his role as grandfather 13 to Bailee, Ethan, Kai, and Landree; and

14 WHEREAS, The face of Bell Helicopter in the community, Mr. Williams was one of the first staff members at the plant when it 15 opened; over the course of his long tenure, he served in a number of 16 key roles, including site leader, director of administration, 17 executive director, and head of human resources; he was a kind 18 mentor to numerous colleagues, and he was known in the wider 19 20 community for his leadership in charitable organizations; 21 dedicated to the United Way of Amarillo and Canyon, he helped raise more than \$5 million as co-chair of its 2008 annual campaign, and he 22 23 served on the executive board for a dozen years; he was a member of many other nonprofit boards as well; and 24
