1-16 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to eliminating provisions requiring public institutions  
 1-19 of higher education to set aside portions of designated tuition for  
 1-20 student financial assistance.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Education Code, is  
 1-23 repealed.

1-24 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply  
 1-25 beginning with tuition charged for the 2018 spring semester.  
 1-26 Tuition charged for any semester or other academic term before the  
 1-27 2018 spring semester is covered by the applicable law as it existed  
 1-28 before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is  
 1-29 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-30 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
