A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the bond required and the bond insurance obtained for
3	certain judges.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 25.0006, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1), (a-2), and
7	(a-3) to read as follows:
8	(a) Notwithstanding any other law, Subsections (a-1),
9	(a-2), and (a-3) control over a specific provision for a particular
10	court or county that attempts to create a requirement for a bond or
11	insurance that conflicts with those subsections.
12	(a-1) Before beginning the duties of the office, the [The]
13	judge of a statutory county court must execute a bond that:
14	(1) is payable to the treasurer of the county;
15	(2) is in the amount set by the commissioners court of:
16	(A) subject to Paragraph (B), not less than
17	\$1,000 nor more than \$10,000; or
18	(B) for a judge who presides in the court over
19	guardianship proceedings, as defined by Section 1002.015, Estates
20	<pre>Code, not less than:</pre>
21	(i) \$100,000 for a court in a county with a
22	population of 125,000 or less; or
23	(ii) \$250,000 for a court in a county with a
24	population of more than 125,000; and

1	(3) is conditioned that the judge will:
2	(A) pay all money that comes into the judge's
3	hands as judge to the person or officer entitled to it;
4	(B) pay to the county all money illegally paid to
5	the judge out of county funds;
6	(C) not vote or consent to pay out county funds
7	for other than lawful purposes; and
8	(D) for a judge who presides in the court over
9	guardianship or probate proceedings, perform the duties required by
10	the Estates Code [as prescribed by law for county judges].
11	(a-2) The bond executed as required by Subsection (a-1) must
12	be approved by the commissioners court.
13	(a-3) In lieu of the bond required by Subsection
14	(a-1)(2)(B), a county may elect to obtain insurance against losses
15	caused by the gross negligence of a judge of a statutory county
16	court in performing the duties of office. The commissioners court
17	of a county shall pay the premium for the insurance out of the
18	general funds of the county.
19	SECTION 2. Section 26.001, Government Code, is amended to
20	read as follows:
21	Sec. 26.001. BOND. (a) Before entering the duties of the
22	office, the county judge must execute a bond that:
23	(1) is payable to the treasurer of the county;
24	(2) is in the amount set by the commissioners court of $\underline{:}$
25	(A) subject to Paragraph (B), not less than
26	\$1,000 nor more than \$10,000 <u>; or</u>
27	(B) for a county judge presiding in the county

- 2 1002.015, Estates Code, not less than:
- 3 (i) \$100,000 for a court in a county with a
- 4 population of 125,000 or less; or
- 5 (ii) \$250,000 for a court in a county with a
- 6 population of more than 125,000; and
- 7 (3) is conditioned that the judge will:
- 8 (A) pay all money that comes into the judge's
- 9 [his] hands as county judge to the person or officer entitled to it;
- 10 (B) pay to the county all money illegally paid to
- 11 the judge out of county funds; [and]
- 12 (C) not vote or consent to pay out county funds
- 13 for other than lawful purposes; and
- 14 (D) for a county judge presiding in the county
- 15 court over guardianship or probate proceedings, perform the duties
- 16 <u>required by the Estates Code</u>.
- 17 (b) The bond <u>executed as required by Subsection (a)</u> must be
- 18 approved by the commissioners court.
- (c) In lieu of the bond required by Subsection (a)(2)(B), a
- 20 county may elect to obtain insurance against losses caused by the
- 21 county judge's gross negligence in performing the duties of office.
- 22 The commissioners court of a county shall pay the premium for the
- 23 <u>insurance out of the general funds of the county.</u>
- 24 SECTION 3. A judge of a statutory county court, a statutory
- 25 probate court, or a constitutional county court who is serving on
- 26 the effective date of this Act shall comply with the requirements of
- 27 Section 25.0006 or 26.001, Government Code, as amended by this Act,

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- 1 as applicable, not later than November 1, 2017.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
