A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the appointment by certain elected officials of
3 students to receive a Texas Armed Services Scholarship.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 61.9772(b), Education Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (b) In each year, the governor and the lieutenant governor
8 may each appoint two students and two alternates and each state
9 senator and each state representative may appoint one student and
10 one alternate to receive an initial scholarship under this
11 subchapter. If a student appointed under this subsection to
12 receive a scholarship fails to initially meet eligibility or
13 otherwise meet the requirements to initially receive the
14 scholarship, the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board must
15 notify the alternate on file of their nomination.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
