1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the appointment by certain elected officials of
1-20 students to receive a Texas Armed Services Scholarship.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 61.9772(b), Education Code, is amended
1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (b) In each year, the governor and the lieutenant governor
1-25 may each appoint two students and two alternates and each state
1-26 senator and each state representative may appoint one student and
1-27 one alternate to receive an initial scholarship under this
1-28 subchapter. If a student appointed under this subsection to
1-29 receive a scholarship fails to initially meet eligibility or
1-30 otherwise meet the requirements to initially receive the
1-31 scholarship, the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board must
1-32 notify the alternate on file of their nomination.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
