## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to financial eligibility for the Texas home living (TxHmL)
- 3 waiver program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 32.0521 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.0521. FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY FOR TEXAS HOME LIVING
- 8 (TxHmL) WAIVER PROGRAM. A person is financially eligible to
- 9 participate in the Texas home living (TxHmL) waiver program if the
- 10 person's income is not more than 300 percent of the monthly income
- 11 limit for eligibility for Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- 12 benefits under 42 U.S.C. Section 1381 et seq.
- SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 14 a state agency determines that a waiver, an amendment to an existing
- 15 waiver, or another authorization from a federal agency is necessary
- 16 for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the
- 17 provision shall request the waiver, amendment to the existing
- 18 waiver, or other authorization and may delay implementing that
- 19 provision until the waiver, amendment, or authorization is granted.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
