BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 254.036, Election Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (f-1) to read as follows: 8 (f-1) A report filed under this chapter with an authority 9 other than the commission may be filed electronically by using 10 computer software developed by the commission, if the authority 11 12 with whom the report is required to be filed has adopted rules and procedures to provide for the filing of the report using the 13 14 software. SECTION 2. Sections 571.0671(a), (b), and (c), Government 15 Code, are amended to read as follows: 16 (a) Computer software provided or approved by the 17 commission for use under Section 254.036(b), Election Code, or 18 Section 302.013, [or] 305.0064, or 572.0291 must: 19 20 (1) use a standardized format for the entry of names, 21 addresses, and zip codes; 22 (2) provide for secure and encoded transmission of 23 data from the computer of a person filing a report to the computers used by the commission; 24

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S.B. No. 63 (3) be capable of being used by a person with basic 2 computing skills;

3 (4) provide confirmation to a person filing a report4 that the report was properly received; and

5 (5) permit a person using a computer to prepare a 6 report or to retrieve information from a report to import 7 information to the report from a variety of computer software 8 applications that meet commission specifications for a standard 9 file format or export information from the report to a variety of 10 computer software applications that meet commission specifications 11 for a standard file format without the need to reenter information.

(b) Before determining the specifications for computer software developed, purchased, or licensed for use under Section 254.036, Election Code, or Section 302.013, [or] 305.0064, or <u>572.0291</u>, the commission shall conduct at least one public hearing to discuss the specifications. For at least 10 days following the hearing, the commission shall accept public comments concerning the software specifications.

The commission may provide software for use under 19 (c) Section 254.036(b), Election Code, or Section 302.013, [or] 20 305.0064, or 572.0291 by making the software available on the 21 22 Internet. If the commission makes the software available on the 23 Internet, the commission is not required to provide the software on 24 computer diskettes, CD-ROMs, or other storage media without charge to persons required to file reports under that section, but may 25 26 charge a fee for providing the software on storage media. A fee under this subsection may not exceed the cost to the commission of 27

1 providing the software.

2 SECTION 3. Section 572.023, Government Code, is amended by 3 adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:

4 (e) Each financial statement filed with a filing authority 5 other than the commission that is not filed electronically must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the person required to file 6 7 the financial statement. The affidavit must contain the statement: "I swear, or affirm, under penalty of perjury, that the 8 accompanying financial statement is true and correct and includes 9 all information required to be reported by me under Chapter 572 of 10 the Government Code." A financial statement filed under this 11 12 chapter is considered to be under oath by the person required to file the financial statement, and the person is subject to 13 prosecution under Chapter 37, Penal Code, regardless of the absence 14 of or a defect in the affidavit. 15

16 (f) A person who electronically files a financial statement 17 with the commission or another filing authority is not required to 18 include a notarized affidavit with the financial statement if the 19 person:

20 <u>(1) has requested and received an electronic filing</u> 21 <u>password pursuant to the rules of the commission or other</u> 22 <u>authority, as applicable; and</u>

23 (2) uses that password to file the financial 24 statement.

25 SECTION 4. Section 145.004, Local Government Code, is 26 amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

27 (h) A financial statement filed under this chapter may be

filed electronically by using computer software developed by the 1 Texas Ethics Commission if the clerk or secretary of the 2 municipality with whom the statement is required to be filed has 3 adopted rules and procedures to provide for the filing of the 4 statement using the software. 5 6 SECTION 5. Section 159.004(f), Local Government Code, is 7 amended to read as follows: 8 (f) A county clerk may adopt rules and procedures under this 9

9 section relating only to the manner in which a person must 10 electronically file a financial statement and the required format 11 of an electronically filed statement. <u>Those rules may allow a</u> 12 <u>person to file a statement electronically by using computer</u> 13 <u>software developed by the Texas Ethics Commission.</u>

SECTION 6. Section 159.0341(b), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) An officer with whom a report is required to be filed under this subchapter may adopt rules and procedures under this section relating only to the manner in which a person must electronically file a report and the required format of an electronically filed report. <u>Those rules may allow a person to file</u> <u>a report electronically by using computer software developed by the</u> Texas Ethics Commission.

23 SECTION 7. Section 159.053, Local Government Code, is 24 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

25 (d) A financial statement filed under this subchapter may be 26 filed electronically by using computer software developed by the 27 commission if the county clerk with whom the statement is required

1 to be filed has adopted rules and procedures to provide for the 2 filing of the statement using the software.

3 SECTION 8. Section 572.023, Government Code, as amended by 4 this Act, applies only to a financial statement due on or after the 5 effective date of this Act. A financial statement due before the 6 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 7 date the financial statement was due, and the former law is 8 continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
