A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the disposition of state surplus or salvage data 3 processing equipment by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 497.012(b), Government Code, is amended 5 6 to read as follows: 7 If the department determines that it is economically feasible, the department shall repair or refurbish the surplus or 8 salvage data processing equipment. The department shall sell the 9 repaired or refurbished data processing equipment, in the following 10 order of preference, to: 11 12 (1) a school district; 13 (2) [τ] a state agency; 14 (3) [, or] a political subdivision of the state; or 15 (4) a statewide organization described by Section 264.603(a), Family Code, or a local volunteer advocate program, as 16 defined by Section 264.601, Family Code, for use by children or 17 youth in foster care [in that relative order of preference]. 18

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
