S.B. No. 81

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the operations of the Cancer Prevention and Research
3 Institute of Texas.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 572.003(c), Government Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (c) The term means a member of:

- 8 (1) the Public Utility Commission of Texas;
- 9 (2) the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
- 10 (3) the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission;

13 (18) the board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement
14 System of Texas;

15 (19) the Credit Union Commission;

16 (20) the School Land Board;

17 (21) the board of the Texas Department of Housing and
18 Community Affairs;

19 (22) the Texas Racing Commission;

20 (23) the State Board of Dental Examiners;

21 (24) the Texas Medical Board;

22 (25) the Board of Pardons and Paroles;

11 SECTION 2. Section 102.107, Health and Safety Code, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Sec. 102.107. POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The oversight
14 committee shall:

- 15 (1) hire a chief executive officer;
- 16 (2) annually set priorities as prescribed by the
- 17 legislature for each grant program that receives money under this
- 18 chapter; and
- 19 (3) consider the priorities set under Subdivision (2)
- 20 in awarding grants under this chapter.

21 (b) The oversight committee may conduct a closed meeting in
22 accordance with Subchapter E, Chapter 551, Government Code, to
23 discuss issues related to managing, acquiring, or selling
24 securities or other revenue-sharing obligations realized under the
25 standards established as required by Section 102.256.

26 SECTION 3. Section 102.109, Health and Safety Code, is
27 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b)(9), an oversight
2 committee member, program integration committee member, or
3 institute employee may represent the interests of this state by
4 serving in an unpaid position on the board of directors of a grant
5 recipient only after the institute has awarded the grant to the
6 grant recipient.

7 SECTION 4. Section 102.203(e), Health and Safety Code, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 (e) Not more than 10 percent of the money appropriated by
10 the legislature for grants in a state fiscal year [~~awarded under~~
11 ~~this subchapter~~] may be used for cancer prevention and control
12 programs during that [~~any~~] year.

13 SECTION 5. Section 102.251, Health and Safety Code, is
14 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

15 (f) The institute may not award a grant to an applicant who
16 has on the applicant's board of directors an oversight committee
17 member, program integration committee member, or institute
18 employee.

19 SECTION 6. Section 102.256, Health and Safety Code, is
20 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

21 (c) The oversight committee may transfer its management and
22 disposition authority over the state's interest in royalties,
23 income, and other benefits realized as a result of projects
24 undertaken with money awarded under Subchapter E to the Texas
25 Treasury Safekeeping Trust Company. If the oversight committee
26 transfers management and disposition authority under this
27 subsection, the Texas Treasury Safekeeping Trust Company has any

1 power necessary to accomplish the purposes of this section.

2 SECTION 7. Section 102.101(f), Health and Safety Code, is
3 repealed.

4 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
