A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the Internet broadcast of certain open meetings.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 551.024 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 551.024. INTERNET BROADCAST AND ARCHIVE OF OPEN
7	MEETINGS. (a) This section applies only to a governmental body
8	that is an agency within the executive or legislative branch of
9	state government to which the total appropriation made in the
10	General Appropriations Act from general revenue for any fiscal year
11	beginning on or after September 1, 2017, including any amount of
12	general revenue transferred to the governmental body under that Act
13	for that fiscal year, is greater than \$40 million and for which the
14	bill pattern for the General Appropriations Act for the same fiscal
15	year designates 250 or more full-time employees.
16	(b) A governmental body that becomes subject to this section
17	under Subsection (a) for a fiscal year shall comply with this
18	section in each following fiscal year.
19	(c) A governmental body subject to this section shall
20	broadcast over the Internet live video and audio of each open
21	meeting of the governmental body. The governmental body shall
22	provide access to the broadcast on the governmental body's Internet
23	website.
24	(d) Not later than the seventh day after the date an open

1 meeting is broadcast under this section, the governmental body
2 shall make available through the governmental body's Internet
3 website archived video and audio of the open meeting. The
4 governmental body shall maintain the archived video and audio of
5 the open meeting on the governmental body's Internet website until
6 the second anniversary of the date the archived video and audio was
7 first made available on the website.

8 (e) The governmental body shall provide on the governmental 9 body's Internet website the same notice of the open meeting that the 10 governmental body is required to post under Subchapter C. The 11 notice must be posted on the governmental body's Internet website 12 within the time required for posting notice under Subchapter C.

13 (f) The governmental body may use for an Internet broadcast 14 of an open meeting of the governmental body a room made available to 15 the governmental body on request in any state building, as that term 16 is defined by Section 2165.301.

17 (g) The governmental body is exempt from the requirements of 18 this section to the extent a catastrophe, as defined by Section 19 551.0411, or a technical breakdown prevents the governmental body 20 from complying with this section. Following the catastrophe or 21 technical breakdown, the governmental body shall make all 22 reasonable efforts to make the required video and audio of the open 23 meeting available in a timely manner.

(h) The governmental body shall consider contracting
 through competitive bidding with a private individual or entity to
 broadcast and archive an open meeting subject to this section to
 minimize the cost of complying with this section.

SECTION 2. Section 551.024, Government Code, as added by
 this Act, applies only to an open meeting held on or after September
 1, 2019.
