A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the inclusion of education and training regarding human
- 3 trafficking in the curriculum of commercial driver's license
- 4 training programs offered by public junior colleges and career
- 5 schools and colleges and to certain requirements for commercial
- 6 driver's licenses.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Section 130.0105 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 130.0105. COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE TRAINING
- 11 PROGRAM; CERTAIN CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS. (a) The Texas Higher
- 12 Education Coordinating Board by rule shall require each public
- 13 junior college offering a commercial driver's license training
- 14 program to include as a part of that program education and training
- 15 on the recognition and prevention of human trafficking.
- 16 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, in
- 17 collaboration with the office of the attorney general, shall
- 18 establish the content of the education and training required by
- 19 this section.
- 20 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 132, Education Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 132.006 to read as follows:
- Sec. 132.006. COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE TRAINING
- 23 PROGRAM; CERTAIN CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS. (a) The commission by
- 24 rule shall require each career school or college offering a

- 1 commercial driver's license training program to include as a part
- 2 of that program education and training on the recognition and
- 3 prevention of human trafficking.
- 4 (b) The commission, in collaboration with the office of the
- 5 attorney general, shall establish the content of the education and
- 6 training required by this section.
- 7 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 522, Transportation Code,
- 8 is amended by adding Section 522.035 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 522.035. RECOGNITION AND PREVENTION OF HUMAN
- 10 TRAFFICKING. The department shall provide informational materials
- 11 regarding the recognition and prevention of human trafficking for
- 12 distribution to commercial driver's license applicants. The
- 13 <u>department may coordinate with organizations that specialize in the</u>
- 14 recognition and prevention of human trafficking to provide
- 15 informational materials as required by this subsection.
- SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 1, 2017, the Texas
- 17 Higher Education Coordinating Board shall adopt rules necessary to
- 18 implement Section 130.0105, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 19 (b) Not later than December 1, 2017, the Texas Workforce
- 20 Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement Section
- 21 132.006, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- (c) Not later than December 1, 2017, the Department of
- 23 Public Safety shall provide informational materials as required by
- 24 Section 522.035, Transportation Code, as added by this Act.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
