## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 522.021, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:
7	(a-2) An applicant for a commercial driver's license must
8	furnish to the department evidence satisfactory to the department
9	that the applicant has successfully completed a recognition and
10	prevention of human trafficking training course approved by the

- SECTION 2. Section 522.022, Transportation Code, is amended

- 14 Sec. 522.022. LICENSE REQUIREMENTS. The department may
- 15 not issue a commercial driver's license other than a non-domiciled
- 16 license to a person unless the person:

- 17 (1) has a domicile:
- 18 (A) in this state; or
- 19 (B) in another state and is a member of the United
- 20 States armed forces, including a member of the National Guard or a
- 21 reserve or auxiliary unit of any branch of the armed forces, whose
- 22 temporary or permanent duty station is located in this state;
- 23 (2) has passed knowledge and skills tests for driving
- 24 a commercial motor vehicle that comply with minimal federal

- 1 standards established by 49 C.F.R. Part 383, Subparts G and H; [and]
- 2 (3) has completed a recognition and prevention of
- 3 human trafficking training course approved by the department under
- 4 Section 522.035; and
- 5 (4) has satisfied the requirements imposed by the
- 6 federal act, federal regulation, or state law.
- 7 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 522, Transportation Code,
- 8 is amended by adding Section 522.035 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 522.035. RECOGNITION AND PREVENTION OF HUMAN
- 10 TRAFFICKING TRAINING COURSE. (a) The department by rule shall:
- 11 (1) prescribe minimum standards for the training
- 12 course on the recognition and prevention of human trafficking that
- 13 <u>is required for commercial driver's license applicants under</u>
- 14 Section 522.022; and
- 15 (2) develop an approval procedure for training courses
- 16 that meet the minimum standards prescribed under this subsection.
- 17 (b) In adopting the rules, the department may consult with
- 18 organizations that develop training courses on the recognition and
- 19 prevention of human trafficking.
- SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 1, 2017, the
- 21 Department of Public Safety shall adopt rules necessary to
- 22 implement Section 522.035, Transportation Code, as added by this
- 23 Act.
- (b) The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an
- 25 application for an original commercial driver's license submitted
- 26 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for an
- 27 original commercial driver's license submitted before the

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- 1 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 2 application was submitted, and the former law is continued in
- 3 effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
