12	(c) Of the savings retained by the agency, one-half:
13	(1) must be used to make additional principal payments
14	for general obligation bonds issued by the agency or on behalf of

16	(2) if there are no outstanding general obligation
17	bonds issued by the agency or on behalf of the agency by the Texas

1 (C) is directly responsible for or worked in a department, office, or other division within the agency that is 2 responsible for the savings realized. 3 4 (d) If the amount of agency savings verified under Section 2108.102, expressed as a percentage of the total amount of 5 undedicated general revenue derived from nonfederal sources 6 7 appropriated to the agency for the fiscal year in which the savings were realized, is: 8 9 (1) less than three percent, a bonus described by Subsection (c)(2) may not exceed \$250; 10 (2) at least three percent but less than five percent, 11 a bonus described by Subsection (c)(2) may not exceed \$500; 12 13 (3) at least five percent but less than 10 percent, a bonus described by Subsection (c)(2) may not exceed \$750; and 14 (4) 10 percent or more, a bonus described by 15 16 Subsection (c)(2) may not exceed \$1,000. 17 (e) A state agency may not provide a bonus under Subsection (c)(2) to an employee of the agency who serves in an upper 18 management position, including the chief executive or chief 19 20 administrator of the agency. (f) A state agency shall adopt rules to implement this 21 22 section. SECTION 2. This Act applies to notice under 23 Section 2108.101, Government Code, of savings from appropriations to a 24 25 state agency for a state fiscal year beginning on or after September 1, 2017. 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 27
