## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the submission of a report by certain entities
3	identifying spending reduction measures.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 322, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 322.025 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 322.025. REPORT ON SPENDING REDUCTION MEASURES.
8	(a) Not later than September 1 of each even-numbered year, each

- entity that is required to submit a legislative appropriations request shall submit to the board a detailed report identifying 10
- measures by which the entity may reduce its expenditures from 11
- 12 general revenue and general revenue-dedicated accounts by 1
- 13 percent, 5 percent, and 10 percent in the next state fiscal
- 14 biennium.

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- 15 (b) An entity described by Subsection (a) shall rank each of
- the 1 percent, 5 percent, and 10 percent spending reduction 16
- measures from highest to lowest priority. The entity shall assign 17
- 18 higher priority to measures that:
- 19 (1) have fewer consequences for the entity's programs
- 20 and goals;
- (2) have less impact on populations served by the 21
- 22 entity; or
- 23 (3) eliminate redundancies and inefficiencies.
- (c) An entity described by Subsection (a) may not include in 24

- 1 the report a spending reduction measure that would violate the
- 2 state or federal constitution.
- 3 (d) The board may exempt certain expenditures from
- 4 consideration under this section.
- 5 <u>(e)</u> The board may issue guidance regarding:
- 6 (1) standards for reports required by this section,
- 7 including format, content, and methods of submission; and
- 8 (2) prioritizing spending reduction measures under
- 9 Subsection (b).
- 10 (f) The board may require an entity to submit the report
- 11 under this section with the entity's legislative appropriations
- 12 request.
- 13 (g) Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year,
- 14 the board shall make reports received under this section available
- 15 to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 16 representatives, and members of the legislature.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
