BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 322, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 322.025 to read as follows:

Sec. 322.025. REPORT ON SPENDING REDUCTION MEASURES. Not later than September 1 of each even-numbered year, each entity that is required to submit a legislative appropriations request shall submit to the board a detailed report identifying measures by which the entity may reduce its expenditures from general revenue and general revenue-dedicated accounts by 1 percent, 5 percent, and 10 percent in the next state fiscal biennium. (b)

An entity described by Subsection (a) shall rank each of 1 percent, 5 percent, and 10 percent spending reduction measures from highest to lowest priority. The entity shall assign higher priority to measures that:

have fewer consequences for the entity's programs

- An entity described by Subsection (a) may not include in a spending reduction measure that would violate the (c) report state or federal constitution.
