1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to requirements for participants in extracurricular
 1-24 athletic activities sponsored or sanctioned by the University
 1-25 Interscholastic League, including a sudden cardiac arrest
 1-26 awareness form.

1-27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-28 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
 1-29 amended by adding Section 33.095 to read as follows:

1-30 Sec. 33.095. DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPANTS IN
 1-31 EXTRACURRICULAR ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES. (a) The University
 1-32 Interscholastic League shall create an informational sudden
 1-33 cardiac arrest awareness form for school districts to provide to a
 1-34 parent of or person standing in parental relation to a student who
 1-35 wants to participate in an athletic activity sponsored or
 1-36 sanctioned by the University Interscholastic League. The form must
 1-37 include information relating to sudden cardiac arrest, including:

- 1-38 (1) a description of a sudden cardiac arrest;
- 1-39 (2) the causes of a sudden cardiac arrest;
- 1-40 (3) the symptoms and warning signs of a sudden cardiac
 1-41 arrest;

- 1-42 (4) the treatments for a sudden cardiac arrest; and
- 1-43 (5) options for screening for sudden cardiac arrest
 1-44 that may be discussed with the student's physician.

1-45 (b) If a student is required under University
 1-46 Interscholastic League rule or policy to receive a physical
 1-47 examination before being allowed to participate in an athletic
 1-48 activity sponsored or sanctioned by the University Interscholastic
 1-49 League, a school district may not allow a district student to
 1-50 participate in the activity unless the student provides:

- 1-51 (1) documentation of the physical examination; and
- 1-52 (2) the informational sudden cardiac arrest awareness
 1-53 form described by Subsection (a) signed by the parent of or person
 1-54 standing in parental relation to the student.

1-55 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2018-2019
 1-56 school year.

1-57 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-58 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-59 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-60 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2-1 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
