4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 5, Alcoholic Beverage
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 5.071 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 5.071. INTERNET BROADCAST AND ARCHIVE OF OPEN
8	MEETINGS. (a) The commission shall:

- 9 (1) broadcast over the Internet live video and audio 10 of each meeting of the commission that is an open meeting subject to 11 Chapter 551, Government Code;
- 12 (2) make a video and audio recording of reasonable
 13 quality of the broadcast; and
- 14 (3) provide access to the archived video and audio of 15 the meeting on the commission's Internet website.
- 16 (b) Not later than the seventh day after the date an open meeting of the commission is broadcast under this section, the 17 commission shall make available through the commission's Internet 18 website archived video and audio of the meeting. The commission 19 shall maintain the archived video and audio of the meeting on the 20 21 commission's Internet website for not less than two years after the date the archived video and audio was first made available on the 22 23 website.
- 24 (c) The commission shall provide on the commission's

- 1 Internet website the same notice of an open meeting of the
- 2 commission that the commission is required to post under Subchapter
- 3 C, Chapter 551, Government Code. The notice must be posted on the
- 4 commission's Internet website within the time required for posting
- 5 notice under that subchapter.
- 6 (d) The commission may use for an Internet broadcast of an
- 7 open meeting of the commission under this section a room made
- 8 available to the commission on request in any state building, as
- 9 that term is defined by Section 2165.301, Government Code.
- 10 (e) The commission is exempt from the requirements of this
- 11 section to the extent a catastrophe, as defined by Section
- 12 551.0411, Government Code, or a technical breakdown prevents the
- 13 commission from complying with this section. Following the
- 14 catastrophe or technical breakdown, the commission shall make all
- 15 reasonable efforts to make the required video and audio of the open
- 16 meeting available in a timely manner.
- 17 (f) The commission shall consider contracting through
- 18 competitive bidding with a private individual or entity to
- 19 broadcast and archive an open meeting subject to this section to
- 20 minimize the cost of complying with this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 5.071, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as added
- 22 by this Act, applies only to an open meeting held on or after
- 23 September 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
