1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the sunset review date for the Cancer Prevention and
1-20 Research Institute of Texas and the time for awarding cancer
1-21 research and prevention grants.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 102.003, Health and Safety Code, is
1-24 amended to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 102.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The Cancer Prevention and
1-26 Research Institute of Texas is subject to Chapter 325, Government
1-27 Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided
1-28 by that chapter, the institute is abolished and this chapter
1-29 expires September 1, 2023 [2021].

1-30 SECTION 2. Section 102.254, Health and Safety Code, is
1-31 amended to read as follows:

1-32 Sec. 102.254. PERIOD FOR AWARDS. The oversight committee
1-33 may not award money under Subchapter E [~~before January 1, 2008, or~~
1-34 after August 31, 2022 [2020].

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
