- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 161.089, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 161.089. PREEMPTION OF LOCAL LAW. (a) This subchapter
- 9 does not preempt a local regulation of the sale, distribution, or
- 10 use of cigarettes or tobacco products or affect the authority of a
- 11 political subdivision to adopt or enforce an ordinance or
- 12 requirement relating to the sale, distribution, or use of
- 13 cigarettes or tobacco products if the regulation, ordinance, or
- 14 requirement:
- 15 (1) is compatible with and equal to or more stringent
- 16 than a requirement prescribed by this subchapter; or
- 17 (2) relates to an issue that is not specifically
- 18 addressed by this subchapter or Chapter 154 or 155, Tax Code.
- (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a municipality may
- 20 <u>adopt an ordinance prohibiting or limiting the sale or distribution</u>
- 21 of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco products to a person under
- 22 21 years of age. Sections 161.088 and 161.090 do not apply to the
- 23 enforcement of an ordinance adopted as described by this
- 24 subsection.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter N, Chapter 161, Health and Safety
- 2 Code, is amended by adding Section 161.258 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 161.258. LOCAL REGULATION OF CIGARETTES,
- 4 E-CIGARETTES, OR TOBACCO PRODUCTS. (a) A municipality may adopt an
- 5 ordinance prohibiting or limiting the possession, purchase,
- 6 consumption, or receipt of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco
- 7 products by a person under 21 years of age.
- 8 <u>(b) Sections 161.252-161.257 do not apply to the</u>
- 9 enforcement of an ordinance adopted as described by this section.
- 10 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to an ordinance adopted on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 An ordinance adopted before the effective date of this Act is
- 13 governed by the law in effect on the date the ordinance was adopted,
- 14 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
