A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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	AN ACT

- 2 relating to providing for voter registration at a polling place
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Election Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 12.007 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 12.007. CERTAIN ELECTION OFFICERS ARE VOTER
- 7 REGISTRARS. An election officer serving a polling place for early
- 8 voting by personal appearance is a deputy voter registrar and has
- 9 the same authority as a regular deputy registrar.
- SECTION 2. Section 65.051(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) The early voting ballot board shall verify and count
- 13 provisional ballots as provided by this subchapter not later than
- 14 the 10th [seventh] day after the date of an election.
- SECTION 3. Section 65.054, Election Code, is amended by
- 16 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 17 follows:
- 18 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), a [A]
- 19 provisional ballot may be accepted only if the board determines
- 20 that, from the information in the affidavit or contained in public
- 21 records, the person is eligible to vote in the election and has not
- 22 previously voted in that election.
- 23 (b-1) A provisional ballot cast under Section 85.0312 shall
- 24 be accepted if the voter registrar determines the applicant is

- 1 eligible for registration under Section 85.0312(d).
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 67.003, Election Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 67.003. TIME FOR LOCAL CANVASS. (a) Except as
- 5 provided by Subsection (b), each local canvassing authority shall
- 6 convene to conduct the local canvass at the time set by the
- 7 canvassing authority's presiding officer not earlier than the $\underline{11th}$
- 8 [eighth] day or later than the 14th [11th] day after election day.
- 9 (b) For an election held on the uniform election date in
- 10 May, the local canvass must occur not later than the 14th [11th] day
- 11 after election day and not earlier than the later of:
- 12 (1) the third day after election day;
- 13 (2) the date on which the early voting ballot board has
- 14 verified and counted all provisional ballots, if a provisional
- 15 ballot has been cast in the election; or
- 16 (3) the date on which all timely received ballots cast
- 17 from addresses outside of the United States are counted, if a ballot
- 18 to be voted by mail in the election was provided to a person outside
- 19 of the United States.
- 20 SECTION 5. Subchapter B, Chapter 85, Election Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 85.0312 to read as follows:
- Sec. 85.0312. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE DURING EARLY
- 23 VOTING WITH PRESENTATION OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION. (a) A person who
- 24 would be eligible to vote in an election under Section 11.001, but
- 25 for the requirement to be a registered voter, shall be accepted
- 26 during early voting by personal appearance for voting the ballot
- 27 for the precinct of the person's residence as shown by the

- 1 identification presented if, on the day the person offers to vote,
- 2 the person:
- 3 (1) submits a voter registration application that
- 4 complies with Section 13.002 to an election officer at the polling
- 5 place; and
- 6 (2) presents as proof of residence a photo
- 7 identification under Section 63.0101(a) that states the person's
- 8 current address on the day the person seeks to vote.
- 9 <u>(b) The election officer shall return the original proof of</u>
- 10 residence to the voter.
- 11 <u>(c) A person voting under this section shall vote a</u>
- 12 provisional ballot in the manner provided by Section 63.011 except
- 13 that the person is not required to submit the affidavit under
- 14 Section 63.011(a).
- 15 (d) For each registration corresponding to a ballot cast
- 16 under this section, the voter registrar shall review the
- 17 application and determine whether the applicant is eligible for
- 18 registration as provided by Subchapter C, Chapter 13. The
- 19 registrar shall inform the early voting ballot board of a
- 20 determination made under this subsection. A registration approved
- 21 under this subsection takes effect on the date the vote was cast.
- (e) The secretary of state may by rule:
- 23 (1) designate additional documents that a person may
- 24 offer to prove the person's residence to register and vote under
- 25 this section; and
- 26 (2) prescribe procedures to implement this section.
- 27 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
