A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the submission of an affordability and access report by

- 3 public institutions of higher education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 51.4031(a) and (d), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Not later than November 1 of each year, the chief
- 8 executive officer of each institution of higher education, as
- 9 defined by Section 61.003, shall provide to the governing board of
- 10 the institution and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board a
- 11 report for the preceding fall, spring, and summer semesters that
- 12 examines the affordability and access of the institution.
- 13 (d) An institution's report must be in the form prescribed
- 14 by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board in consultation
- 15 with the institution. The coordinating board shall provide a
- 16 report received under this section to the governor, the lieutenant
- 17 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each
- 18 member of the legislature. The coordinating board may provide the
- 19 report electronically.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
