2 relating to the submission of an affordability and access report by

3 public institutions of higher education.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

examines the affordability and access of the institution.

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5 SECTION 1. Sections 51.4031(a) and (d), Education Code, are 6 amended to read as follows:

- 7 (a) Not later than November 1 of each year, the chief 8 executive officer of each institution of higher education, as 9 defined by Section 61.003, shall provide to the governing board of 10 the institution and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board a 11 report for the preceding fall, spring, and summer semesters that
- 13 (d) An institution's report must be in the form prescribed
 14 by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board in consultation
 15 with the institution. The coordinating board shall provide a
 16 report received under this section to the governor, the lieutenant
 17 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each
 18 member of the legislature. The coordinating board may provide the
 19 report electronically.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
