- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2157.068, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 7 (k) To ensure accuracy, the department shall, in
- 8 cooperation with state agencies, monitor and verify the purchase
- 9 transaction reports submitted in accordance with department
- 10 requirements by vendors reflecting monthly sales of commodity items
- 11 included on the list maintained under Subsection (e).
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 2155.504(a), Government Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (a) Except as provided by this subsection, a [A] state
- 15 agency or local government may purchase goods or services directly
- 16 from a vendor under a contract listed on a schedule developed under
- 17 this subchapter. A state agency or local government contracting
- 18 for the purchase of an automated information system shall comply
- 19 with Section 2157.068(e-1). A purchase authorized by this section
- 20 satisfies any requirement of state law relating to competitive bids
- 21 or proposals [and satisfies any applicable requirements of Chapter
- $22 \frac{2157}{1}$.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only in
- 24 relation to a contract:

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- 1 (1) for which a state agency or local government first
- 2 advertises or otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or
- 3 qualifications on or after the effective date of this Act;
- 4 (2) that is extended or modified on or after the
- 5 effective date of this Act; or
- 6 (3) for which a change order is submitted on or after
- 7 the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
