1-19 relating to the handgun proficiency required to obtain or renew a
 1-20 license to carry a handgun.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 411.188(a), Government Code, is amended
 1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (a) The director by rule shall establish minimum standards
 1-25 for handgun proficiency and shall develop a course to teach handgun
 1-26 proficiency and examinations to measure handgun proficiency. The
 1-27 course to teach handgun proficiency is required for each person who
 1-28 seeks to obtain a license and must contain training sessions
 1-29 divided into two parts. One part of the course must be classroom
 1-30 instruction and the other part must be range instruction and an
 1-31 actual demonstration by the applicant of the applicant's ability to
 1-32 safely and proficiently use a handgun. An applicant must be able to
 1-33 demonstrate, at a minimum, the degree of proficiency that is
 1-34 required to effectively operate a handgun [~~of .32 caliber or~~
 1-35 ~~above~~]. The department shall distribute the standards, course
 1-36 requirements, and examinations on request to any qualified handgun
 1-37 instructor.

1-38 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-39 to an application to obtain or renew a license to carry a handgun
 1-40 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An
 1-41 application submitted before the effective date of this Act is
 1-42 governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted,
 1-43 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-44 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
