A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the expression of breast milk in the Capitol and other public buildings. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by 5 adding Section 443.0134 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 443.0134. PLACE TO EXPRESS BREAST MILK. The board 7 shall provide a place in the Capitol, other than a bathroom, that is 8 shielded from view and free from intrusion of any person where a 9 member of the public or an employee can express breast milk. 10 SECTION 2. Section 619.004, Government Code, is amended to 11 12 read as follows: 13 Sec. 619.004. PUBLIC EMPLOYER RESPONSIBILITIES. (a) А 14 public employer shall: (1) provide a reasonable amount of break time for an 15 employee to express breast milk each time the employee has need to 16 express the milk; and 17 18 (2) provide a place, other than a [multiple user] bathroom, that is shielded from view and free from intrusion from 19 other employees and the public where the employee can express 20 21 breast milk. 22 (b) A public employer that engages in or contracts for the 23 construction or renovation of any building in which the public employer is housed shall ensure that the building includes a 24

1 publicly accessible place, other than a bathroom, that is shielded
2 from view and free from intrusion of another person where a member

3 of the public can express breast milk.

4 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date 5 of this Act, the State Preservation Board shall establish a place in 6 the Capitol for a person to express breast milk as required by 7 Section 443.0134, Government Code, as added by this Act.

8 SECTION 4. Section 619.004(b), Government Code, as added by 9 this Act, applies only to the construction or renovation of a 10 building in which a public employer is housed that begins on or 11 after the effective date of this Act.

12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
