(a) A student may transfer to another public school campus as provided by this section if the campus to which the student seeks 10 to transfer is assigned an overall performance rating under Section 11 39.054 that is at least two letter grades higher than the overall 12 performance rating under Section 39.054 assigned to the campus the 13 student would otherwise attend. 14 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a student may 15 16 transfer in accordance with Subsection (a) to another campus in the district in which the student resides or to another campus 17 in another district. 18 (c) A school district shall admit a student entitled to 19 transfer under this section to the campus selected by the student 20 unless the campus does not have available capacity. A school 21 district that receives more requests to transfer to a campus under 22 23 this section than the number of available positions at the campus must fill the available positions by lottery. 24

1	(d) After a student transfers to another campus in
2	accordance with this section, the student may continue attending
3	that campus in subsequent school years regardless of the subsequent
4	overall performance ratings under Section 39.054 of the campus to
5	which the student transferred and the campus that the student would
6	otherwise attend.
7	(e) A student who transfers to another campus under this
8	section, including a campus in a district other than the district in
9	which the student resides, may not be charged tuition. The student
10	is included in the average daily attendance of the district in which
11	the student attends school.
12	(f) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to implement

14	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
15	amended by adding Section 42.1571 to read as follows:
16	Sec. 42.1571. TRANSFER STUDENT ALLOTMENT. (a) Except as
17	provided by Subsection (b), for each student in average daily
18	attendance who transfers in accordance with Section 25.044 to a
19	campus in a district other than the district in which the student
20	resides, the district in which the student attends school is
21	entitled to an annual allotment equal to the adjusted basic
22	allotment multiplied by a weight of 0.1.
23	(b) The total number of allotments under this section to
24	which a district is entitled may not exceed the number by which the
25	number of students transferring to campuses in the district exceeds
26	the number of students who reside in the district and transfer in
27	accordance with Section 25.044 to campuses in another district.
