5	SECTION 1. Section 42.001, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) It is the policy of this state that the state's
8	contribution to the financing of public education should not
9	decrease as a result of an increase in local property values. To
10	further that policy, the legislature shall provide in the General
11	Appropriations Act for a basic allotment under Section 42.101 and a
12	guaranteed level of state and local funds per weighted student per
13	cent of tax effort under Section 42.302 that are sufficient to
14	result in at least a level of state expenditure equal to the state's
15	expenditure for the preceding biennium.
16	SECTION 2. Chapter 46, Education Code, is amended by adding
17	Subchapter E to read as follows:

## SUBCHAPTER E. STATE POLICY

19 Sec. 46.101. STATE POLICY. It is the policy of this state that the state's assistance in the financing of instructional 20 21 facilities and payment of existing debt should not decrease as a result of an increase in local property values. To further that 22 policy, the legislature shall provide in the General Appropriations 23 Act for a guaranteed level of state and local funds per student per 24

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- 1 cent of tax effort under Sections 46.003 and 46.032 that are
- 2 sufficient to result in at least a level of state expenditure under
- 3 this chapter equal to the state's expenditure under this chapter
- 4 for the preceding biennium.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
