1-26 relating to the creation and funding of the Texas Forensic Science
 1-27 Commission operating account.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Article 38.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
 1-30 amended by adding Section 13 to read as follows:

1-31 Sec. 13. TEXAS FORENSIC SCIENCE COMMISSION OPERATING
 1-32 ACCOUNT. The Texas Forensic Science Commission operating account
 1-33 is an account in the general revenue fund. The commission shall
 1-34 deposit fees collected under Section 4-a for the issuance or
 1-35 renewal of a forensic analyst license to the credit of the account.
 1-36 Money in the account may be appropriated only to the commission for
 1-37 the administration and enforcement of this article.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
