- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 102.006, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A court that grants a petition for expunction of a
- 8 criminal record may order that any fee, or portion of a fee,
- 9 required to be paid under this article or other law in relation to
- 10 the petition be returned to the petitioner.
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to a petition for expunction filed on or after the effective date of
- 13 this Act. A petition for expunction filed before the effective date
- 14 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the petition
- 15 was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 16 purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
