- the Texas Juvenile Justice Department, a juvenile facility, [or] a 1 2 local juvenile probation department, or a community supervision and corrections department established under Chapter 76, Government 3 Code, a person other than an employee who works for compensation at 4 a juvenile facility or local juvenile probation department, or a 5 volunteer at a juvenile facility or local juvenile probation 6 7 <u>department</u> commits an offense if the <u>actor</u> [<u>employee</u>] engages in sexual contact, sexual intercourse, or deviate sexual intercourse 8 with an individual who the actor [employee] knows is under the supervision of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Texas 10 11 Juvenile Justice Department, [or] probation department, or community supervision and corrections department but not in the 12 13 custody of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Texas Juvenile Justice Department, [or probation department, or community 14 15 supervision and corrections department.

The change in law made by this Act applies only 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 19 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 22 before that date. 23
