- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 573.001(d), Health and Safety Code, is 5
- amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 A peace officer who takes a person into custody under
- Subsection (a) shall immediately: 8
- 9 (1) transport the apprehended person to:
- 10 (A)  $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$  the nearest appropriate
- 11 mental health facility; or
- 12 (B) [(2)] a mental health facility
- suitable by the local mental health authority, if an appropriate 13
- inpatient mental health facility is not available; or 14
- (2) transfer the apprehended person to a licensed 15
- paramedic in accordance with Section 573.005 to transport to a 16
- facility described by Subdivision (1)(A) or (B). 17
- 18 SECTION 2. Sections 573.002(a), (d), and (e), Health and
- Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: 19
- 20 A peace officer shall immediately file with a facility a
- 21 notification of detention after transporting a person to that
- facility in accordance with Section 573.001. A licensed paramedic 22
- 23 who transports a person to a facility at the request of a peace
- officer under Section 573.005 shall immediately file with the 24

- 1 A mental health facility or hospital emergency department may not
- 2 require a peace officer or licensed paramedic to execute any form
- 3 other than this form as a predicate to accepting for temporary
- 4 admission a person detained by a peace officer under Section
- 5 573.001, [Texas] Health and Safety Code, and transported by the
- 6 officer under that section or by a licensed paramedic at the request
- 7 of the officer under Section 573.005, Health and Safety Code.
- 8 (e) A mental health facility or hospital emergency
- 9 department may not require a peace officer or licensed paramedic to
- 10 execute any form other than the form provided by Subsection (d) as a
- 11 predicate to accepting for temporary admission a person detained by
- 12 <u>a peace officer</u> under Section 573.001 <u>and transported by the</u>
- 13 officer under that section or by a licensed paramedic at the request
- 14 of the officer under Section 573.005.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 573, Health and Safety
- 16 Code, is amended by adding Section 573.005 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 573.005. TRANSPORTATION FOR EMERGENCY DETENTION BY
- 18 LICENSED PARAMEDIC. (a) A peace officer may request a licensed
- 19 paramedic to transport a person taken into custody by the officer
- 20 under Section 573.001 only if the officer determines transferring
- 21 the person to the licensed paramedic for transport is safe for the
- 22 person and the paramedic.
- 23 (b) A licensed paramedic may, at the request of a peace
- 24 officer, transport a person taken into custody by the officer under
- 25 <u>Section 573.001</u> to the appropriate facility as provided by that
- 26 section.
- 27 (c) A peace officer who transfers a person to a licensed

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- 1 paramedic under this section to be transported to the appropriate
- 2 facility must provide:
- 3 (1) to the person the notice described by Section
- 4 573.001(g); and
- 5 (2) to the paramedic a completed notification of
- 6 detention about the person on the form provided by Section
- 7 <u>573.002(d)</u>.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 573.021(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A facility shall temporarily accept a person for whom an
- 11 application for detention is filed or for whom a peace officer or
- 12 licensed paramedic files a notification of detention completed by
- 13 the peace officer under Section 573.002(a).
- 14 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
