## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the regulation of automotive wrecking and salvage yards 1-20 in certain counties. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 397.0125(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) In addition to the penalty provided by Section 397.012, 1-25 a person who operates an automotive wrecking and salvage yard in violation of this chapter is liable for a civil penalty of not less than \$500 or more than  $\frac{$5,000}{[\$1,000]}$  for each violation. A 1-26 1-27 1-28 separate penalty may be imposed for each day a continuing violation 1-29 occurs.

1-30 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a violation of Chapter 397, Transportation Code, that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. A violation of that chapter that occurred before the effective date of this Act is 1-31 1-32 1-33 1-34 governed by the law in effect when the violation occurred, and the 1-35 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-36

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
