## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the use of certain unspent bond proceeds and voter
- 3 approval of certain political subdivision actions, including the
- 4 issuance of certain bonds and the use of certain unspent bond
- 5 proceeds.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 52.072(e), Election Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (e) In addition to any other requirement imposed by law for
- 10 a proposition, including a provision prescribing the proposition
- 11 language, a proposition submitted to the voters by a political
- 12 <u>subdivision</u> for approval of the issuance of bonds or the
- 13 imposition, increase, or reduction of a tax shall specifically
- 14 state, as applicable:
- 15 (1) with respect to a proposition seeking voter
- 16 approval of the issuance of bonds:
- 17 (A) the total principal amount of the bonds to be
- 18 authorized, if approved; and
- 19 (B) each specific purpose [a general description
- 20 of the purposes] for which the bonds are to be authorized, if
- 21 approved;
- 22 (2) with respect to a proposition that only seeks
- 23 voter approval of the imposition or increase of a tax, the amount of
- 24 or maximum tax rate of the tax or tax increase for which approval is

- 1 sought; or
- 2 (3) with respect to a proposition that only seeks
- 3 voter approval of the reduction of a tax, the amount of tax rate
- 4 reduction or the tax rate for which approval is sought.
- 5 SECTION 2. Subtitle C, Title 9, Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Chapter 1253 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 1253. USE OF BOND PROCEEDS BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS FOR
- 8 OTHER PURPOSES
- 9 Sec. 1253.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "political
- 10 subdivision" means a county, municipality, school district, junior
- 11 college district, other special district, or other subdivision of
- 12 state government.
- Sec. 1253.002. USE OF UNSPENT GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND
- 14 PROCEEDS. A political subdivision may use the unspent proceeds of
- 15 <u>issued general obligation bonds only:</u>
- 16 (1) for the specific purpose for which the bonds were
- 17 issued;
- 18 (2) to retire the bonds; or
- 19 (3) for a purpose other than the specific purpose for
- 20 which the bonds were issued if:
- 21 (A) the specific purpose is accomplished or
- 22 <u>abandoned; and</u>
- (B) a majority of the votes cast in an election
- 24 held in the political subdivision approve the use of the proceeds
- 25 for the proposed purpose.
- Sec. 1253.003. ELECTION PROCEDURES. (a) The election
- 27 order and the notice of election for an election authorized to be

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- 1 held under Section 1253.002 must state the proposed purpose for
- 2 which the bond proceeds are to be used.
- 3 (b) A political subdivision must hold the election in the
- 4 same manner as an election to issue bonds in the political
- 5 <u>subdivision</u>.
- 6 SECTION 3. Chapter 1332, Government Code, is repealed.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 52.072(e), Election Code, as amended by
- 8 this Act, applies only to an election ordered on or after the
- 9 effective date of this Act. An election ordered before the
- 10 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 11 election was ordered.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.
