## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to abolishing the Events trust fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 1(1-a), (2), (2-a), and (8), Chapter
- 5 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 6 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1-a) "Endorsing county" means an endorsing county for
- 9 purposes of Section 5, 5A, or 5B[<del>, or 5C</del>] of this Act.
- 10 (2) "Endorsing municipality" means an endorsing
- 11 municipality for purposes of Section 4, 5, 5A, or  $5B[\frac{1}{2}]$  of
- 12 this Act.
- 13 (2-a) "Event" means a game or event as defined by
- 14 Section 5A or  $[\tau]$ 5B $[\tau]$  of this Act.
- 15 (8) "Site selection organization" means a site
- 16 selection organization as defined by Sections 5 and  $[\tau]$  5A $[\tau]$  and 5C $[\tau]$
- 17 of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 7(a), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of
- 19 the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14,
- 20 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) The department shall review requests from a local
- 22 organizing committee, endorsing municipality, or endorsing county
- 23 that the department, on behalf of the state, enter into a games
- 24 support contract that is required by a site selection organization

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- 1 in connection with the committee's, municipality's, or county's bid
- 2 to host any of the games. This section does not affect or apply to
- 3 an event support contract under Section 5A  $\underline{\text{or}}$  [7] 5B[7 or 5C] of
- 4 this Act to which the department is not a party.
- 5 SECTION 3. (a) On September 1, 2017:
- 6 (1) Section 5C, Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the
- 7 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's
- 8 Texas Civil Statutes), is repealed; and
- 9 (2) each Events trust fund established under Section
- 10 5C, Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular
- 11 Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is
- 12 abolished.
- 13 (b) The applicable provisions of Section 5C, Chapter 1507
- 14 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999
- 15 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), as that section
- 16 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 17 including any trust fund established under that section, remain in
- 18 effect as those provisions apply in relation to the particular
- 19 events described by this subsection until all money from the trust
- 20 fund for the particular event has been disbursed and all
- 21 obligations under an event support contract for the particular
- 22 event have been satisfied. This subsection applies only if, before
- 23 the effective date of this Act:
- 24 (1) pursuant to an application by a local organizing
- 25 committee, endorsing municipality, or endorsing county, a site
- 26 selection organization selects a site in this state for a
- 27 particular event to which Section 5C, Chapter 1507, applies; and

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- 1 (2) one or more event support contracts for the 2 particular event have been entered into.
- 3 SECTION 4. The repeal by this Act of Section 5C, Chapter
- 4 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 5 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), does not
- 6 apply to an offense committed under Chapter 1507 before September
- 7 1, 2017. An offense committed before September 1, 2017, is governed
- 8 by the law as it existed on the date the offense was committed, and
- 9 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 10 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before September
- 11 1, 2017, if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
