## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the exception from disclosure under the public
- 3 information law for information related to competition or bidding.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.104, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.104. EXCEPTION: INFORMATION RELATED TO
- 8 COMPETITION OR BIDDING. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c),
- 9 information [Information] is excepted from the requirements of
- 10 Section 552.021 if a governmental body demonstrates that release of
- 11 the [it is] information [that, if released,] would harm its
- 12 <u>interests by providing an</u> [give] advantage to a competitor or
- 13 bidder in a particular competitive situation.
- 14 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the [The]
- 15 requirement of Section 552.022 that a category of information
- 16 listed under Section 552.022(a) is public information and not
- 17 excepted from required disclosure under this chapter unless
- 18 expressly confidential under law does not apply to information that
- 19 is excepted from required disclosure under this section.
- 20 (c) The exception to disclosure provided by Subsection (a)
- 21 does not apply to:
- (1) a bid or proposal, or information contained in a
- 23 bid or proposal, after the governmental body executes or awards the
- 24 contract to which the bid or proposal relates; or

- 1 (2) an account, voucher, or contract, or information
- 2 <u>contained in or describing an account, voucher, or contract.</u>
- 3 (d) Section 552.305 does not apply to the exception under
- 4 this section.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 552.305(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) In a case in which information is requested under this
- 8 chapter and a person's privacy or property interests may be
- 9 involved, including a case under Section 552.101, [552.104,]
- 10 552.110, or 552.114, a governmental body may decline to release the
- 11 information for the purpose of requesting an attorney general
- 12 decision.
- 13 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 14 a request for information received by a governmental body or an
- 15 officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 16 this Act. A request for information received before the effective
- 17 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the request
- 18 was received, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 19 purpose.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
